

Sewing Supply Checklist for Dwight Mission Quilting Retreat

- Sewing Machine and all accessories
- Power strip/extension cords (we will have some spread throughout the rooms)
- Machine Presser feet specific to project
- Extra machine needles
- Cleaning supplies for machine
- Small rotary cutting mat
- Rotary Cutter and extra blades
- Correct Ruler and extra you might need
- Thread (and extra colors)
- Hand sewing needles
- Pins & Pincushions
- Seam Ripper
- Tape Measure
- Small iron such as a travel iron
- Light
- Scissors to cut paper
- Fabric markers
- Cushion for chair (padding for both back and bottom as needed)
- Your own sewing chair (if you would like and you have room in the car)
- Organizer for sewing tools (to sit on the table or pin to the wall)
- Mechanical Pencil
- Sand Paper board
- Stiletto or bamboo skewer
- Extra projects (bring more than you think you will need)
- Extra fabric
- Tape – masking, blue painter's or "Scotch"
- Thimble for hand work
- Freezer Paper and/or fusible web for appliqué
- Appliqué pressing sheet
- Stabilizers and toppings for machine embroidery
- Machine embroidery threads
- Machine embroidery needles
- Machine embroidery hoops
- 505 Spray
- Thread stand
- Machine embroidery bobbin thread

Be SURE to bring everything you will need. There is no fabric department in the Sallisaw Wal-Mart. There is a quilt shop located in Gore, approx 30 minutes away, or Fort Smith has a few options, approx. an hour away.
